
CYCLING, WALKING & JOGGING ROUTES AT WHATLEY MANOR





WHATLEY MANOR TO THE VINE TREE INN BY SKEPPSCHULT BICYCLE

This cycle tour will lead you to one of the best public houses in the area through the tranquillity of the Wiltshire countryside. The ride will take approximately thirty minutes to reach 'The Vine Tree'. Total biking time one hour and ten minutes.

- Leave Whatley Manor via the main entrance.
- Turn left at the end of the driveway onto the B4040 main road and carry on until you reach the next crossing signposted Norton.
- At the crossing turn left and follow the signpost to Norton. You will cycle through Easton Grey taking in the surrounding countryside until you reach the small village of Norton.
- A crossing will follow where you will see the sign for 'The Vine Tree'. Turn left and a few minutes later on you will see the establishment on your left hand side.
- On leaving 'The Vine Tree' turn left and stay on this road until you reach Foxley.
- Take a left following the signpost to Sherston.
 Stay on this road until the next crossing.
- At the next crossing turn left again. After a while you will pass Easton Grey. Take the next right.
- This short road will take you back to the Sherston B4040 where you turn right and the main entrance of Whatley Manor will be on the right hand side roughly about a mile.
- · Please take extreme care on the main road.



WHATLEY MANOR TO THE CAT & CUSTARD POT INN RAMBLE ROUTE

The Cat & Custard Pot Inn closes at 3.00pm daily and re-opens at 6.00pm. This tranquil walk will take you through typical Wiltshire countryside. It is recommended that you wear Wellington boots or proper walking shoes. The walk will take you approximately sixty minutes until you reach the Cat & Custard Pot Inn. Total walking time two hours.

- Leave Whatley Manor via the main entrance.
 Turn right at the end of the driveway onto the main road. Please take extreme care on the road and use the grass verge to stay off the road and oncoming cars.
- Take the first turn to the left and stay on this road until you reach the first crossing.
- At the crossing turn right and follow the fields, keeping to the left hand side.
- When you see the main road on the right, turn left and after a few meters take another right, carry on until you reach the main road.
- At the main road take a left and stay on this road until you reach the village of Shipton Moyne.
 As you enter the village you will see the Cat & Custard Pot Inn on the left hand side.
- For your return to Whatley Manor take a right in the direction of Malmesbury.
- After the crossing take the public bridleway on the right. Stay on this bridleway leading you directly to another bridleway where you have to turn right again. This will eventually bring you back to the Sherston B4040 where you turn left and the main entrance of Whatley Manor will be on the right hand side.



WHATLEY MANOR JOGGING ROUTE

Taking in the fresh country air this short run keeps mainly to side roads, bridleways and fields. The run will take approximately thirty to forty minutes.

- · Leave Whatley Manor via the main entrance.
- Turn left at the end of the driveway onto the main road. Please take extreme care on the road and use the grass verge to stay away from the road and oncoming vehicles.
- Take the first turn to the right onto the bridleway.
- Stay on the bridleway until you reach 'Upper Fosse Farm' on the right. Take the first left after 'Upper Fosse Farm'.
- Continue running on the bridleway until you reach the main road in Shipton Moyne.
- Turn right and stay on this road until you see another bridleway on the right hand side.
- This will bring you back onto the Sherston B4040. Turn left and the main entrance of Whatley Manor will be on the right hand side.
